GOOD TO KNOW

LOCATION OF AEDs (Defibrillators) AT CHURCH

The church maintains **two AEDs** (defibrillators). We hope we never have to use them, **and** it's a good idea to learn where they are. Look for these when you are in the buildings.

AED #1 Main Building

**Ground Level, near Main Entrance & South Interior
Sanctuary Entrance, on wall beside Sacristy door**

From the Sanctuary:

Exit by the front, South (lectern-side) door. Descend the short flight of steps to the Ground Level. AED will be on the wall to your left beside the door to the Sacristy.

From inside the Receptionist Office:

Exit office to the right. Cross hallway. AED will be on the wall to your right, by Sacristy door and just before the stairs up to the Sanctuary Level.

AED #2 in Christian Education Center (CEC)

**Ground Level, Main Entrance Lobby, on wall
behind CEC Reception Desk**

From Jarrett Hall:

Exit the back of the hall and follow the main hallway to the lobby. Locate large Reception Desk on right. AED will be on the wall behind the desk.
