About the 2019 Recipient Organizations

Cooperative Community Ministry. CCM provides emergency needs relating to health, food, housing, transportation & clothing with the goal of moving individuals in need toward self-sufficiency.

Crossnore School & Children's Home Winston-Salem Campus. Funds will support the "Thrive Scholarship" program which provides outpatient counseling to teens who are underinsured/uninsured. Licensed therapists help these clients learn new strategies to address challenges, break ineffective patterns, evaluate difficult decisions, and overcome obstacles.

Davidson Medical Ministries. Exists in order to improve access to healthcare for eligible residents of Davidson County who are uninsured/underinsured. Medical, Dental, Behavioral Health, and Pharmacy services are available.

Dragonfly House. The Dragonfly House Children's Advocacy Center exists to reduce the devastating long-term effects that all forms of abuse have on children, families and society through immediate, coordinated, child-focused services, education and advocacy.

Lexington Housing Community Development Corporation (LHCDC). Works throughout Davidson County to make a positive impact on affordable housing, provides urgent home repairs, leads financial literacy courses, partners with agencies to prevent foreclosures, and engages the entire community to work for the good of all.

Meals on Wheels Thomasville. Provides meals for homebound seniors Monday - Friday.

PDI or Project Divine Interruption Scholarship Fund. Established by Barbara Greeson in memory of her parents, the purpose is to reward leadership, integrity & drive for students who experienced an interruption in following dreams of a high school diploma, but did not give up. Each spring, a graduating PDI student will benefit from this gift toward a college education.

Rise Against Hunger - Meal Packing Event. ALL donations will help MUMC host a meal-packing event in April 2020.
